### Inauguration of the commemorative table for the conductor Ferenc Fricsay in the town of Budapest

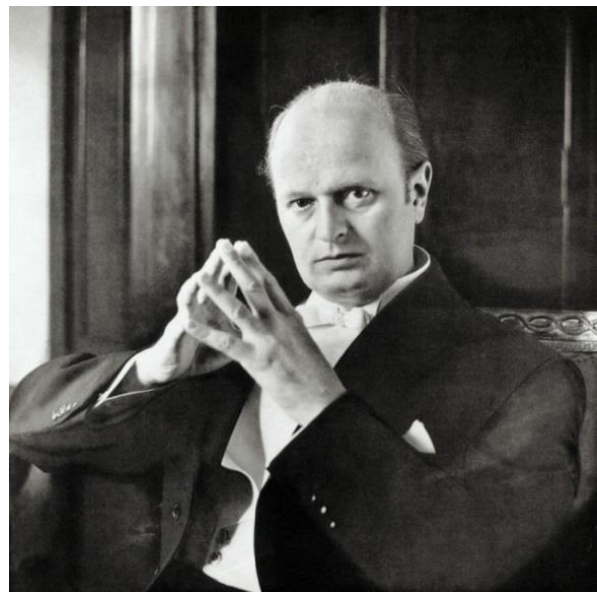


Wednesday, the 30th of July 2014 the commemorative table to honour the conductor and composer Ferenc Fricsay was inaugurated at his formal residential building Julia utca 4, in Budapest. The panel was installed by the National Philharmonic orchestra on the occasion of his 100th birthday.

Abroad Fricsay is a famous personality till today, while in Hungary his name is inexplicable rarely known.

“From today us, the members of the National Philharmonic Orchestra, descendants of the former Orchestra of the Capital, which Ferenc Fricsay conducted 49-times, assume as our duty to maintain his memory. For this reason, we dedicate our concert to Ferenc Fricsay the coming Saturday at Martonvásárhely, “- affirmed Géza Kovács, General Manager of the National Philharmonic Orchestra, during the inauguration of the commemorative table.

Subsequent to the CV of the conductor, who was profoundly attached during his whole life to the National Philharmonic Orchestra, the General Manager added his speech with the following thoughts: „This modest panel may remind passers-by that in Hungary notable personalities saw the light of the world and provided the country with glory. One among those was Ferenc Fricsay as an enrichment of humankind, like any great artist.”
